Canada Summer Student Program - Canada Summer Jobs provides funding to not-for-profit organizations, public-sector employers and small businesses with 50 or fewer employees to create summer job opportunities for young people aged 15 to 30 years who are full-time students intending to return to their studies in the next school year. The deadline for applying has changed from previous years and is now January 30, 2015. For full details on the program, check out the Service Canada website.

PEI's Minimum Wage to Increase. Are you a business owner in PEI? Minimum wage in Prince Edward Island will increase to \$10.50 per hour effective July 1, 2015. Minimum wage across Canada ranges from \$10.00 in New Brunswick and the Northwest Territories to \$11.00 in Ontario and Nunavut.

Nova Scotia's New Statutory Holiday begins February 16, 2015. Nova Scotia is getting another statutory holiday beginning February 16, 2015. The province introduced legislation December 5, 2013 to create a statutory holiday on the third Monday in February, beginning this coming year. Officially called Nova Scotia Heritage Day, the February holiday will recognize significant cultural and historical contributions to Nova Scotia.
