Canada Summer Jobs - It's just coming into the official start of winter next week, so let's look ahead to the warmer months of summer! Canada Summer Jobs provides funding to help employers create summer job opportunities for students. The program provides funding to not-for-profit organizations, public-sector employers and small businesses with 50 or fewer employees to create summer job opportunities for young people aged 15 to 30 years who are full-time students intending to return to their studies in the next school year. The application period will be from January 4 - February 26, 2016. For the full details and applications, check out the <u>Service Canada website</u>.

Two minimum wage increases coming to PEI in 2016. The minimum wage in Prince Edward Island will increase by 50 cents per hour in the coming year. The province's minimum wage was raised to the current \$10.50 per hour on July 1. Cabinet has approved 25-cent increases to take effect on June 1, 2016 and October 1, 2016, bringing the rate to \$10.75 per hour and \$11 per hour on those dates.

This legislation will formalize the recent cooperation of the three Maritime Premiers on red tape reduction and commits the Office of Regulatory Affairs and Service Effectiveness to publicly track progress on reducing the regulatory burden.
